Unique Venues provide a special place for exceptional experiences.

From museums and art galleries to shrines and temples, and from historical buildings to gardens and public spaces, throughout Japan there are locations rooted in the nature, history, arts, customs, or industry of the local region. These places are an important aspect in attracting meetings and events, as utilizing these facilities and spaces as event venues allows visitors to experience first-hand the local customs and culture. Such locations that are specifically rented to meet needs different from their original purposes are called unique venues. Meeting and event planners are always seeking exceptional experiences to ensure the highest satisfaction for their attendees. Utilizing unique venues is an extremely effective way to create unique experiences and environments that can only be found in that specific region, and the existence of such venues is a key factor in deciding an event's host destination.

In order to attract events, a destination must promote the overall advantages of holding events in their specific region, such as the region's conference facilities, accommodations, accessibility, party venues, history and culture, and surrounding tourist attractions. However, it is also important to bring attention to the distinct culture and atmosphere that only that specific area can provide, and unique venues are essential in creating such exceptional experiences.




Osaka unique venues offer experiences unlike anywhere else.

Osaka City Central Public Hall

Theaters/ Halls Historical Architecture





Osaka City Central Public Hall was completed in 1918 after a donation was made by Einosuke Iwamoto, a prominent stockbroker of the time. In the century since its completion, the building has become a cultural and artistic hub cherished by the citizens of Osaka.

In 2002, after additional preservation and restoration work, the building was designated an Important Cultural Property by the national government for its extreme value as a piece of historical architecture. Noted for its interior design as well as beautiful exterior, the Central Public Hall is a defining landmark of Nakanoshima's townscape.





Ohtsuki Noh Theatre is located in a historic area near Osaka Castle and the site of the ancient Naniwa-no-Miya Palace. Built in 1935, the theatre was renovated in 2021 for a more comfortable viewing space. The Noh stage, which has remained unchanged since its original construction, is designated as a Tangible Cultural Heritage and is cherished by people from both Japan and around the world as a unique place to experience this art form.

With a backdrop representing actual-sized stones from Osaka Castle and exquisite traditional pine tree artwork, the theatre offers a beautiful balance between stage and audience that meeting planners can take advantage of for events even outside of theatre.



Kokaido Hall

Historical Architecture





The Kyu-Sakuranomiya Kokaido Hall is a stately piece of historical architecture, built in commemoration of the Meiji Emperor.

Designated as an Important Cultural Property, the Kyu-Sakuranomiya Kokaido Hall and the directly connected Sempukan are said to be one of the oldest modern architecture in Japan.

With a library, gallery, and other historical academic fixtures, the refined atmosphere makes for a truly unique venue for parties and events.

The former headquarters of the 4th Division of the Imperial Japanese Army, the building was used as the Osaka City Museum before opening as a dining complex in 2017. With its prime location, stately atmosphere, and impressive close-up view of Osaka Castle, the Landmark Square Osaka can be used as a restaurant, party space, event venue, and more. It offers a new way to experience Osaka in a space where history and modern trends blend.



Kisshoden

Shrines/ Temples







With 1,800 years of history, Sumiyoshi Taisha is one of the oldest shrines in Japan and represents Osaka's rich history. Its appearance is designed with traditional Japanese beauty in mind. The large banquet can accommodate up to 700 guests, and staff welcome visitors with heartfelt hospitality. All of these elements boast quality that reflects its history.

The historical building that is the "Jinkan" shrine, now designated as a Tangible Cultural Property, is characterized by the palace-style architecture that has been cherished by medieval nobles since ancient times.

Osaka Geihinkan Former Guest House

Historical Architecture

The vast size of Osaka Castle's Nishinomaru Garden defies its location in the heart of the city and provides a scenic oasis year-round. Osaka Geihinkan was once the residence of the wife of Hideyoshi Toyotomi, one of the Great Unifiers of Japan, and is located in the spot that is said to have the most beautiful view of Osaka Castle. During APEC 1995 and G20 Osaka Summit, the Osaka Geihinkan was used as the dinner venue to welcome the heads of state from countries around the world. The restaurant offers authentic French cuisine with a fusion of Japanese taste and cultural experiences.

Yamamoto Noh Theater

Theaters/ Halls Japanese Style Historical Architecture





Located in near Osaka Castle, Yamamoto Noh Theater is the oldest Noh theater in Osaka City with a history of nearly 95 years. The space within the building is utilized in its entirety for performances of traditional stage arts such as Noh, Bunraku, Rakugo, and Kōdan, and is also used as a unique venue for events and receptions.

Offering the chance to experience Osaka's distinct high culture, Yamamoto Noh Theater is a valuable historical building that has played host to many important guests from Japan and abroad, including former British Prime Minister Theresa May as well as the wife of Thailand's former prime minister.

From the architecture, interior design, and furniture to the hospitibale service, everything was created to provide the most satisfying and pleasant experience for its guests. Since the closing of the 1970 World Expo, the building is now used as a private party venue to host conferences and banquets as well as photo and film shooting.

Universe's history as a glamorous cabaret nightclub lives on in its archtecture and design.

Osaka's only streetcar is also Japan's oldest running train. This line includes a route from Tennoji, home to Abeno Harukas, and Ebisucho with Tsutenkaku Tower, all the way to Hamadera Park in Sakai city. This train can be used in a variety of ways to accommodate meeting planners' ideas and needs, such as being chartered to eat and drink while enjoying the passing views. Trains typically depart from Tennoji Station but can depart from Ebisucho or Hamadera Station upon request.



Katsuoji Temple is located in the center of Mino Quasi-national Park and has been worshipped as the temple of luck and victory for 1,300 years, and has preserved a sense of nature unique even to Osaka Prefecture. Visitors can enjoy the different sides of nature, and flowers and birds during different seasons in the 80,000 square meter grounds once they pass through the temple gates. The Ochokaku Quarters offer a Large Hall that can accommodate up to 135 attendees as well as meeting rooms of varying sizes that can be used for an arrary of purposes.




